

The Body and Blood of Christ at Communion

Several weeks ago, following on from discussions at a Pastoral Parish Council meeting, where the subject of the possible re-introduction of Communion of Both Kinds was discussed, a ballot to gauge the wishes of our Parishes congregations was conducted. The result of the ballot fell in favour of not re-introducing the option of offering The Blood of Christ. There are also other reasons why not at this time and even if these are not known or understood, we should accept and honour the decision at this time. Other parishes in the diocese may be in a similar situation as ourselves, but this may change in time. We should be happy to accept communion as it is.
