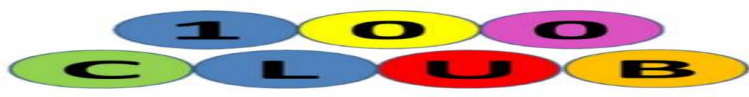
Health Walk
