

#### **Sacramental Preparation**

All parents of children hoping to receive the Sacraments of First Holy Communion & Reconciliation (Confession) or Confirmation next May, are invited to a short meeting with Father, Karolina and Angela, following 11-15 Mass at St Fergus' on Sunday 25th August.
