Sacramental Preparation

All parents of children hoping to receive the Sacraments of First Holy Communion & Reconciliation (Confession) or Confirmation next May, are invited to a short meeting with Father, Karolina and Angela, following 11-15 Mass at St Fergus' on Sunday 25th August. This is to verify if numbers are sufficient to enable classes to take place and to arrange when these weekly classes would suit those wishing to receive the sacraments. Children are usually confirmed in P7, but again, older children are also very welcome. There will also be Children's Liturgy during Mass that day, when children have the opportunity to hear the Gospel story at their level and participate in a related activity (usually craft), in the back room with Angela and Karolina The children then return to their parents at the Offertory. All Children from the age of 4 are most welcome. Please tell any friends or relatives who may have children wishing to receive the Sacraments about this meeting.

New Lectionary and Sunday Missals

A new Lectionary will come into use in all Parishes from 1st Sunday in Advent – December 1st 2024. The Vatican's Dicastrey have approved the proposal by The Bishop's Conference for Scotland, England, Ireland and Wales. "The English Standard version of The Bible" and Abbey Psalter will replace the Jerusalem Bible. This also means the Sunday Missal will change from the First Sunday in Advent. The cost of the Lectionary for each Church will be £695, and the Sunday Missal £19.95 in hardback and in paperback £9.95 to be renewed annually. If anyone would like to donate towards the cost of the Lectionary, please advise Fr Dijo or if anyone wishes to order a new Missal, please speak to Anne Cormie or Fr Dijo.
